There is always a critic, no matter the subject. Use any constructive criticisms to help improve your blog. Negative criticism should just be answered then ignored. Promote your blog through social media outlets, but do not go overboard. If all your tweets are only a link to your blog, then they will be ignored. Provide interesting or useful content in your tweets to keep followers interested.

TIP! Update your site regularly. New content that is fresh and relevant is what will attract and retain your audience.
